

ALIENS (PERMITS FOR PROHIBITED AREAS) REGULATIONS, 1969 (LI 612).

IN exercise of the powers conferred on the Commissioner responsible for the Interior by section 28 of the Aliens Act, 1963 (Act 160) these Regulations are made this 9th day of January, 1969.

Regulation 1—Form to be Completed by Applicants for Permits.

- (1) An alien wishing to enter or remain in a prohibited area in Ghana shall apply for and complete Form A set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.
- (2) An application for Form A as provided under sub-regulation (1) of this Regulation shall be in writing and shall be forwarded to the immigration officer who shall issue the said Form to the applicant upon payment of the fee prescribed in sub-regulation (3) of this Regulation
- (3) A fee of 50Np shall accompany an application for Form A:
 Provided that an applicant who is a public officer is exempted from the payment of such fee.
- (4) An applicant shall complete the said Form A in triplicate and return it to the immigration officer.

Regulation 2—Form and Duration of Permits.

- (1) After the immigration officer has satisfied himself that Form A has been duly completed by an applicant, then subject to the provisions of these Regulations, such applicant may be granted a permit in the form prescribed in Form B of the Schedule to these Regulations.
- (2) The permit referred to in sub-regulation (1) of this Regulation shall be numbered serially and shall be for such period as the immigration officer may decide, but not exceeding one year.
- (3) After the expiration of the period granted by the permit or after a period of one year, as the case may be, an alien may apply for an extension of the period.
- (4) Subject to the provisions of these Regulations, an extension of the period granted by a permit under sub-regulation (3) of this Regulation shall not in any case exceed one year.
- (5) A fee of 25Np shall be paid on application for an extension of a permit granted under these Regulations.

Regulation 3—Immigration Officer to Keep Record of Permits Issued.

The immigration officer shall keep a record of permits issued from time to time under these Regulations.

Regulation 4—Police to Keep Register.

The Inspector-General of Police shall cause to be prepared and kept a register of aliens entering and leaving a prohibited area.

Regulation 5—Interpretation.

In these Regulations, "prohibited area" means the area defined in the Second Schedule to the Aliens Act, 1963 (Act 160) as amended by the Aliens Act, 1963 (Amendment) Decree, 1968 (N.L.C.D. 259).

Regulation 6—Commencement.

These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into force at the same time as the Aliens Act, 1963 (Amendment) Decree, 1968.
