RECRUITMENT SCAM

Accra, 25 January 2019: It has come to the attention of Gold Fields that some individuals have received congratulatory letters, purporting to offer various jobs at the company's Damang mine (operated by Abosso Goldfields Limited).

The letters also demand that payment of GHS487 be made by the supposed successful applicants as registration fee for a compulsory pre-employment seminar.

Gold Fields wishes to state categorically that this is a scam and should be ignored. Those who receive such letters are encouraged to report to the law enforcement agencies. Gold Fields does not, at any point in the recruitment process, require applicants to make payment.
